

PAN (Personal Area Network)

A Personal Area Network (PAN) is a network designed for communication between devices within a very short range, typically around a single person's workspace.

PANs are commonly used for connecting personal devices like laptops, smartphones, tablets, printers, and wearables.



Characteristics of PANs:

□ Very Limited Range: Typically limited to just a few meters.

Focus on Personal Devices: PANs center around an individual's interconnected devices.

Can be Wired or Wireless: PANs can use wired connections (like USB, Thunderbolt) but are more commonly implemented using wireless technologies. ❑ Wireless Technologies: The most popular wireless technologies for PANs include Bluetooth, Infrared (IrDA), and sometimes Wi-Fi.
